- 1 **RED** plastic folder with pockets and prongs – label for English
- 1 **YELLOW** plastic folder with pockets and prongs—label for Reading/Spelling
- 1 **BLACK** plastic folder with pockets and prongs (and 1 sheet protector in the prongs) – label for Library
- 1 **BLUE** plastic folder with pockets – label for Math
- 1 **GREEN** plastic folder with pockets – label for Science/Social Studies
- 1 other **BLACK** plastic folder with pockets (No Prongs) — label for Test Folder
- 2 marble notebooks for interactive notebooks
- 2 one-subject notebooks (any color) – label both for Math
- 2 packs of wide ruled loose-leaf paper
- 1 pair of scissors (avoid really sharp edges)
- 2 packs of crayons (**16 count**)
- 1 pack of markers (**10 count**)
- 1 small pack of colored pencils (**12 count**)
- 1 large ZIPPER pencil pouch (**NO BOXES**)
- 5 packs of pencils (TICONDEROGA if possible) (**NO LEAD PENCILS**)
- 4 DRY ERASE EXPO markers (**BLACK ONLY**)
- 2 packs of small posters (**CAN GET 4-5 PER PACK**)
- 1 set of headphones (label with student's name)
- 3 book covers; paper or fabric stretchy material (**Jumbo size**)
- 4 packs of sticky post-it notes for anecdotal notes while reading
- 1 OF EACH: paper towels, Kleenex/tissue, Clorox/Lysol wipes, hand sanitizer
- 4 **LARGE** glue sticks
- 4 highlighters (**YELLOW ONLY**)
- 1 pack of cardstock (**any LIGHT color**)
